Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT EQUIPMENT DOES MY PLAYER NEED FOR THE SEASON?

- Glove
- Cleats
- Batting helmet with chinstrap
- Fielding mask
- It is also recommended to have a bat to use at home and at practice and games. The league does have some loaner bats and helmets if needed.
- Uniforms shirts will be issued.
- For games, players 10U and up need to wear pants (black softball pants, and sliding shorts are recommended).
- There is a table for swap equipment at the fieldhouse if you are interested in donating anything you aren't using anymore. Anything that you find there is up for grabs if you need it.

AM I SUPPOSED TO ATTEND DRAFT DAY?

Please plan on attending the draft if...

- You are moving up in age group
- You would like to change teams
- Be aware all girls will be assigned to a team whether they attend the draft or not.
- We try to honor team mate/coach requests but they are not guaranteed

WHAT IF I DON'T WANT TO BE DRAFTED BY A CERTAIN COACH?

- There is a place on your registration form to request a coach
- We try to assign girls to teams where they can be comfortable
- Feel free to contact a board member if there are specific concerns

DO I HAVE TO WORK IN THE CONCESSION STAND?

- No, but we would really like it if you did
- You have already paid a \$25 buyout fee. If you come work you get that money back
- It's a fun opportunity, and nothing to stress about. You are only in charge of taking orders and giving change. A board member or substitute will be there to work the grill and fryers for you.
- Allstar parents are REQUIRED to either work a shift during the World Series, or flip fields. There are 5 weekends to choose from.

CAN I BRING MY CHILD IN THE STAND WHILE I WORK?

Yes, if...

- They are 8 years or older
- Children under 16 years of age are not permitted to be on the grill side of the rear counter FOR ANY REASON while the grill or fryers are hot.
- It's a safety risk, and a health department violation.

HOW DO I SIGN UP TO WORK IN THE STAND?
